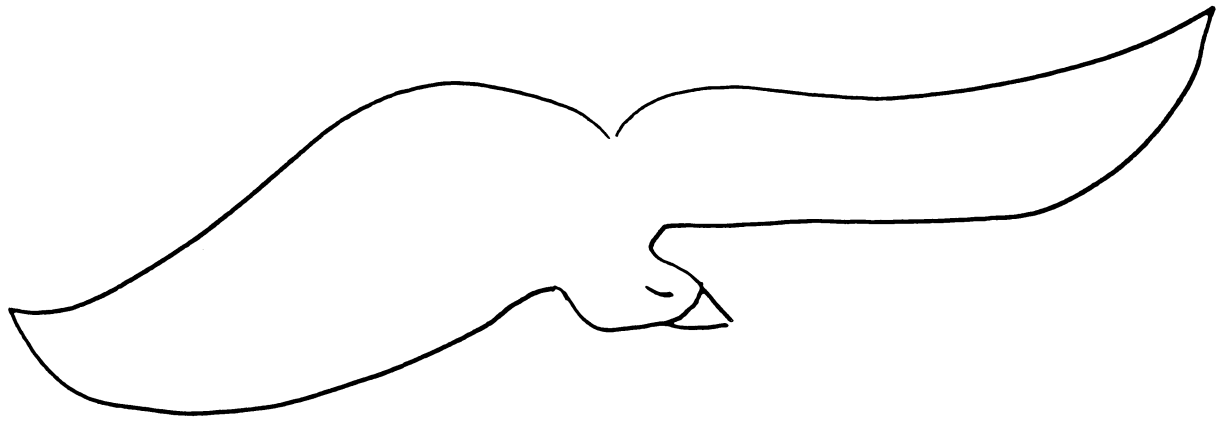
Picture 1, Jesus in Swaddling Clothes

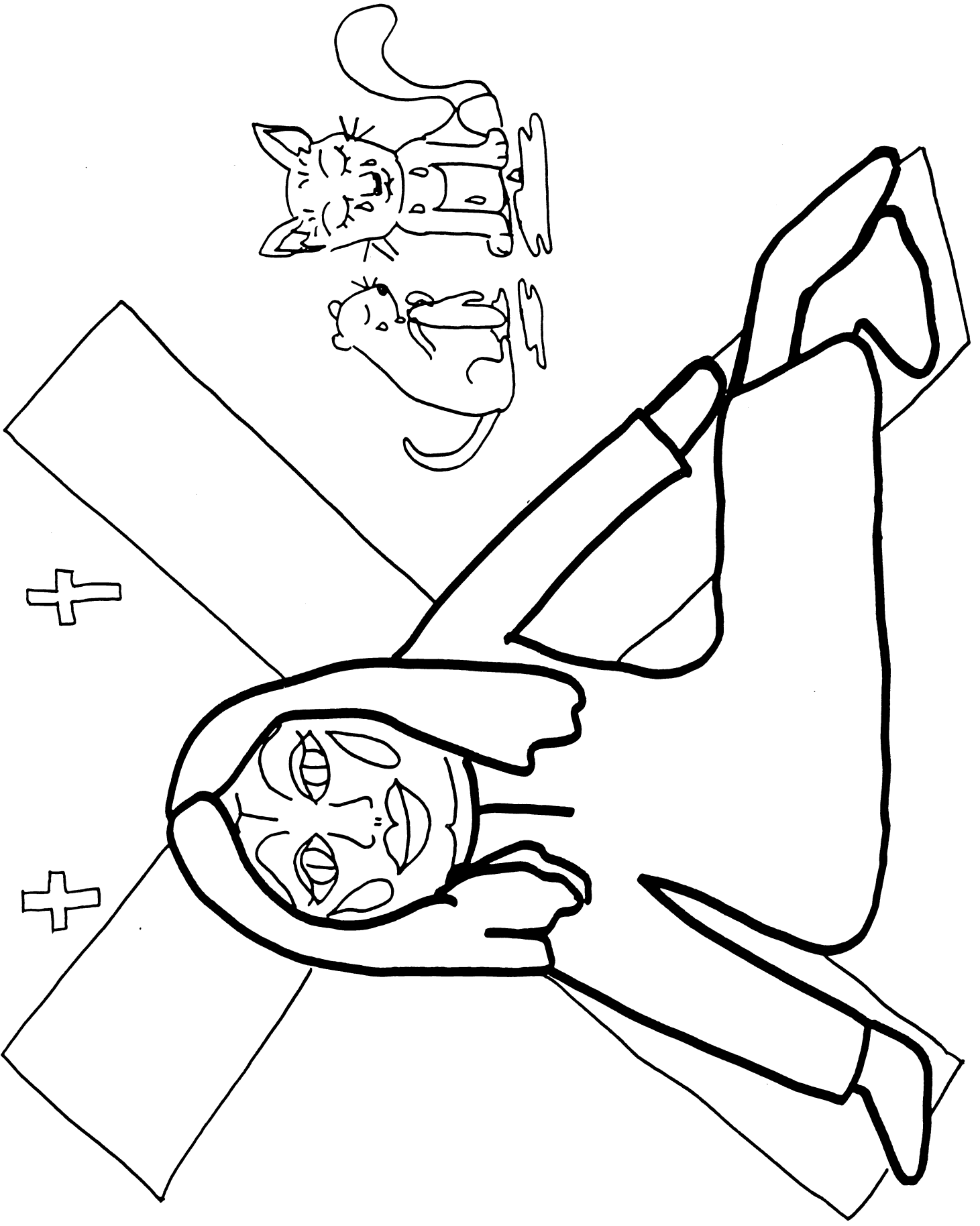
Picture 7, He Is Beaten, Dharma Weeps

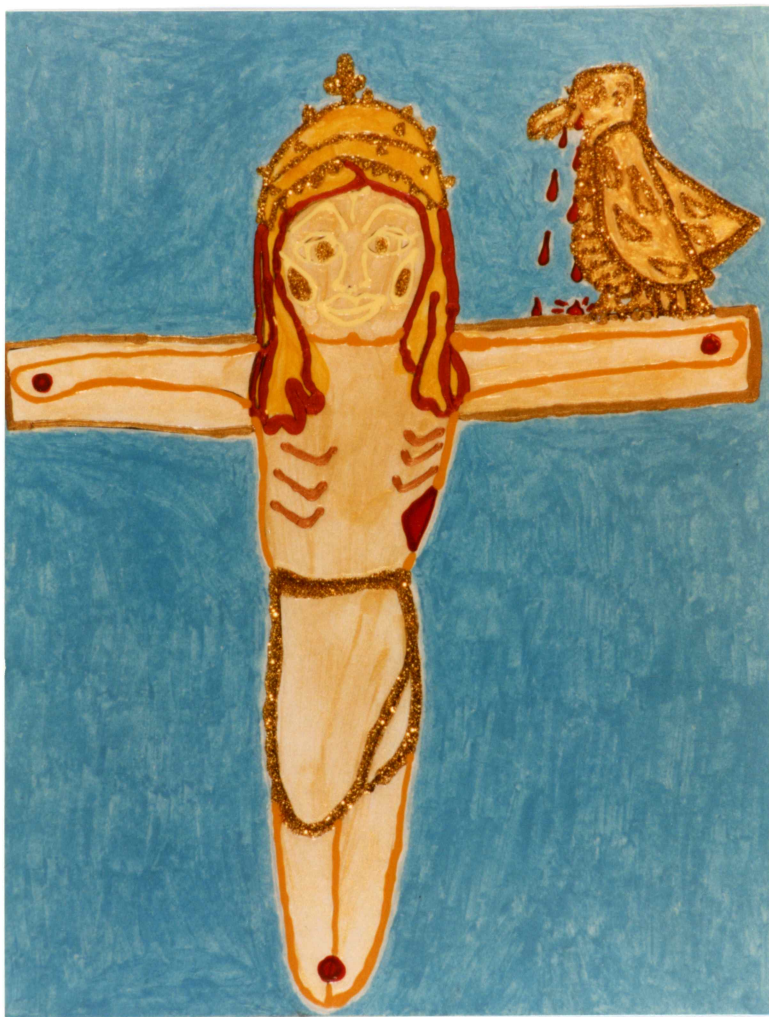


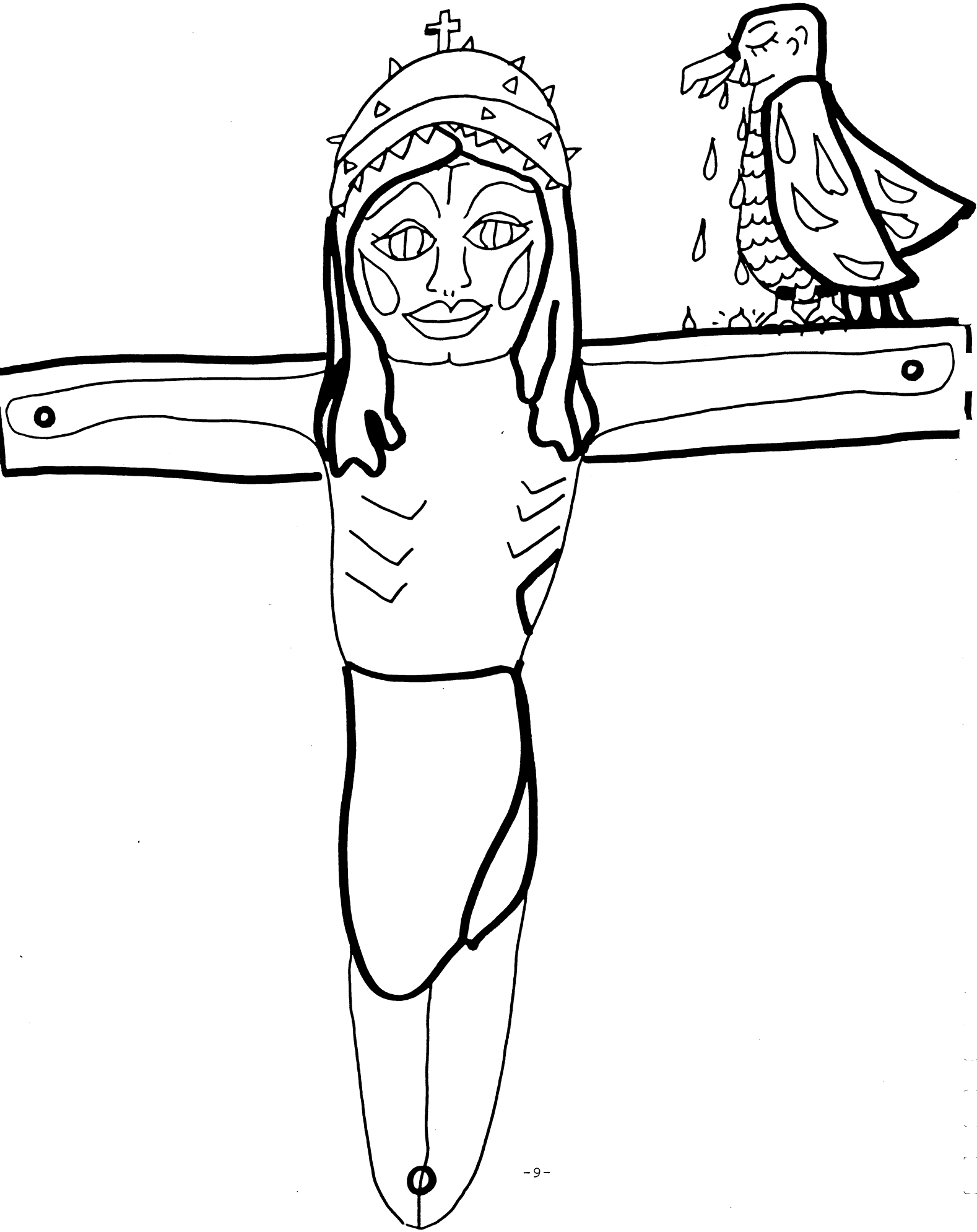
**Picture 8, Jesus Falls**

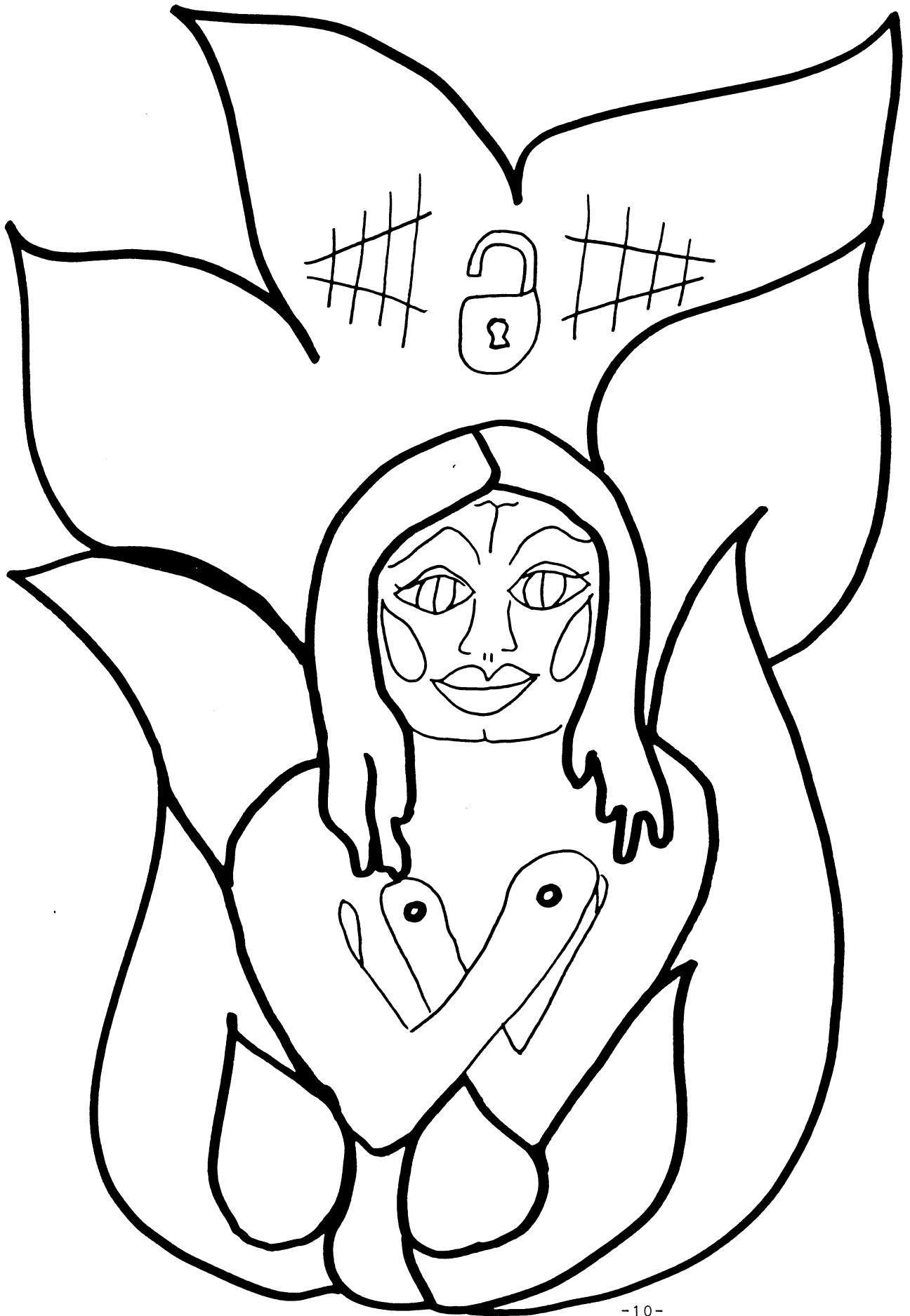
Picture 9, He Is Crucified

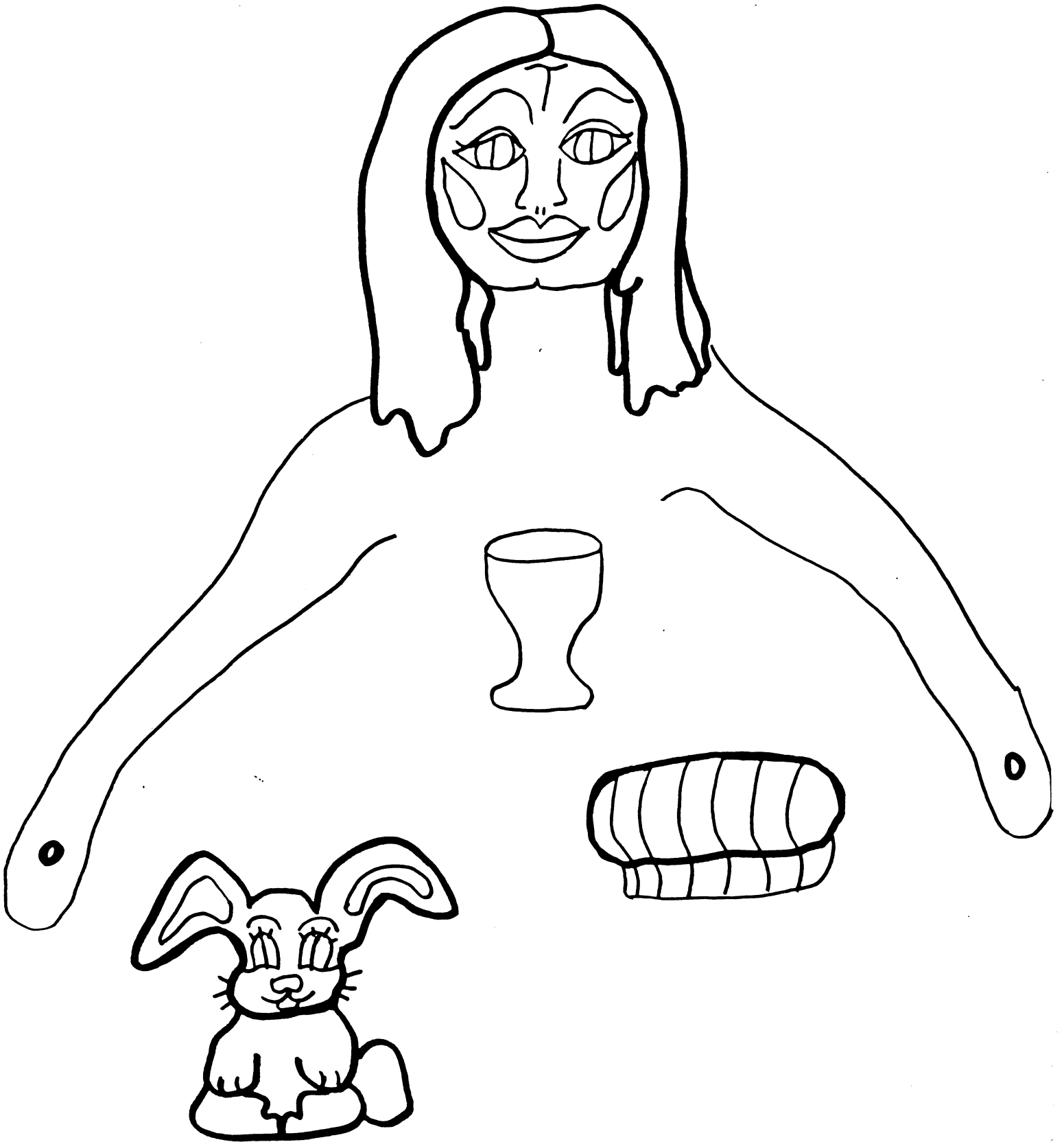
