Justice is the basis of freedom. Freedom cannot

establish itself. It must be established from a condition of justice. The order of priority for policy and execution is first justice then freedom.

Justice is the precondition of freedom. Freedom cannot exist in a condition of injustice. Establish justice and freedom must ring, rain and reign, just as a garden that is cultivated must produce beauty, bliss and benefit.

However, freedom is always paired with its equal and polar opposite, destiny. Life is a forward and upward flow of meaningful, internally directed processes characterized by the polar tension of freedom and destiny. Life constantly transcends itself from given conditions.

Misery is a quality of life produced by conditions that are preventable, non-preventable or a mixture of both. Non-preventable conditions that produce misery include prodigies of nature and processes of life. Preventable conditions that produce misery include carelessness and injustice. Mixtures of preventable and non-preventable conditions that produce misery include participation in a group and in goal-oriented activity.

Only man's actions are judged by the standard of justice. Only man can create conditions of injustice, which produce misery. Nature and animals can create conditions that produce misery but not injustice. Only man can create conditions of injustice, and therefore misery.

Injustice is the most powerful and prolific of all conditions that produce misery. Only man can produce these conditions because only man has freedom to create injustice.

All the worlds are mutually immanent, they interpenetrate one another. Therefore, injustice anywhere spreads misery everywhere. The actual source of misery somewhere may be hidden or apparent.

The apparent condition that produced misery in Iraq and therefore everywhere was injustice created by Saddam Hussein and his cabal.

The hidden condition that produced and produces misery in Iraq, almost the entire Middle East and now everywhere in the world is demonic clergy and schloars:
